Parish Council Vacancies

We hope you don't mind us sending out a short newsletter 'bulletin' ahead of the regular newsletter scheduled for the end of February. But returning the Parish Council to its full complement is both urgent and important.

Following the recent resignations of Bev Crossley and Donna Okell from Willington Parish Council, we have two vacancies on the Council that need filling to bring the Council up to its full quota of five members.

The vacancies will be filled via co-option; there is no requirement to hold an election.

The Parish Council meets every other month (at Willington Hall) on the last Tuesday of the month. The meetings last for about two hours and are the only formal time commitment required of Councillors.
